This workshop introduces its participants to common roles and responsibilities among medical and support staff in hospitals and clinics, "Patient's Rights and Responsibilities," and recommendations for how to advocate for family members to gain access to necessary medical information.

At the conclusion of the workshop, participants will be able to identify at least 3 different members of hospital staff and describe the roles and responsibilities of each, to define at least 2 components of a "Patient's Rights and Responsibilities" that are typically provided by hospitals and clinics, and to apply specific medical terminology to the appropriate professional to better their chances of having an interpreter during an appointment/emergency.
