In this workshop presentation, the presenter will attempt to describe transgenerational trauma by answering the following questions: What is it? Does it exist in the Deaf Community? What are the causes? What do members of the next generation need to be aware of? The participants will learn about the presenter's observation of trauma and its effect on her own family. The participants will then be asked to share their own experiences. The purpose of this will be to draw out common traumatic experiences and to talk about the effects of these experiences in a group discussion format.

1. To identify the definition of transgenerational trauma.
2. To explain possible causations of trauma in the Deaf community
3. To describe behaviors associated with trauma in the Deaf Community.
4. To list barriers to identifying and treating transgenerational trauma
